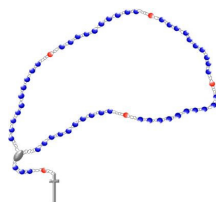

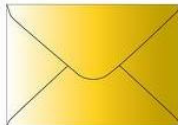

A driver’s license, proof of Social Security number, discounted rate form, and a processing fee of \$37, is required for processing a BCI&I.
