Dear Parishioners:

Today the Church celebrates the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This feast typically falls on the Sunday within the Octave of Christmas. We reflect upon the mystery of the Lord's incarnation and birth, which made him a part of a particular family, as well as a part of the universal human family. 


