**PASTOR'S CORNER**

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. We used to celebrate this important feast 40 days after Easter, on Ascension Thursday. This is based on the statement in the Acts of the Apostles that, after Jesus' Resurrection, He appeared to His disciples "during forty days," until He was taken up to heaven (see Acts 1:3). In the old days, it was the custom to extinguish the paschal candle immediately after the Gospel was proclaimed on Ascension Thursday. I, as an Altar Server in my youth, did the honors of snuffing out the Easter candle numerous times on this feast. The first year I was ordained as a priest, I was celebrating Mass on the Feast of the Ascension, after reading the Gospel, no one extinguished the paschal candle, so I did it myself. After the Mass, the Pastor told me, "we don't do that anymore." The reform of the Liturgy after the Second Vatican Council calls for the paschal candle to remain lit until after Pentecost.

Sunday, May 13, is also Mother's Day, which is also a sort of "holy day," because we revere our mothers and those who have a maternal role, and honor them and their holy vocation of motherhood. May God bless and consecrate all mothers, living and deceased, and give them honors and rewards befitting their dignity and importance!
