PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Parishioners:

This weekend, we celebrate the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, or "Corpus Christi." The feast of Corpus Christi celebrates the mystery of the reality of the true Body and Blood of Christ under signs of bread and wine in the most holy Eucharist.

This feast was promulgated in the year 1264 in the city of Orvieto, Italy by Pope Urban IV. I recall visiting the hilltop city of Orvieto and its grand cathedral back in 1987 when I was a student priest in Rome. The Cathedral displays an interesting relic: a corporal (the linen cloth placed beneath the chalice and paten on the altar) which is stained with blood which miraculously came from the consecrated host centuries ago. The feast of Corpus Christi also emphasizes the practice of Eucharistic Adoration, the worship of the Real Presence of our Savior Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Here at St. Andrew Parish, we offer Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Eucharistic Chapel Monday through Friday after the 6:30 a.m. Mass until 8:15 a.m., and on Tuesdays in Church, from 6:00 p.m. and concluding with Compline (Night Prayer) and Benediction at 8:45 p.m. I encourage you to take advantage of these opportunities to worship our Lord in the Sacrament of His Body and Blood.

I want to wish all fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, and foster fathers a very Happy Father's Day. May you know how important you are and how holy your fatherhood is, as it is derived from the one who is God and Father of all.

Finally, I want to let you all know that I will be on vacation and away from St. Andrew Parish for the next two weeks. I will return on Saturday, July 1. Fr. Tony will be "in charge" during my absence.
