This is a reading technique developed to help children with dyslexia and incorporates the three learning pathways of auditory, kinesthetic and visual. It can be implemented in group and individual settings and in at-risk populations. SPICE is also contributing money to the furnishing of two additional instruction spaces for our specialists.

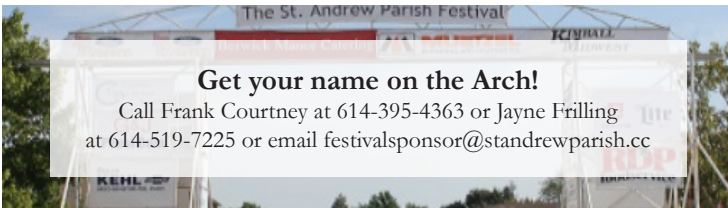


Cakes, pies, brownies, and cookies are needed for the Cake Wheel, Saturday night Italian Dinner and the Pie and Coffee area. You can drop off your
