PASTOR'S COLUMN

Dear Parishioners:

I am pleased to inform you that Bishop Campbell has approved the proposal for the renovation of the lower corridor of St. Andrew School. You may recall that we participated in the #iGiveCatholic program last month, in which we received almost \$12,000 in donations that were designated for this project. I said, at that time, that if we raised enough on "Giving Tuesday," we would proceed with the renovation as a kind of "head start" on future Phase II renovations. I was very happy with the results on Giving Tuesday, combined with the funds left over from Phase I, and the \$100,000 set aside from the sale of the Longhill Road property, we have the funds to do this project. The Parish Finance Council enthusiastically approved proceeding with the project, and now that we have the Bishop's approval, we are completing the plans for the renovation. Construction will take place next summer. Thanks to all who contributed to make this possible!

I also want to give you some advance notice of projects that will take place early next year affecting the church. The church will undergo a thorough cleaning in the next few months. This interior cleaning will involve removing the pews and use of special equipment to reach the ceilings and overhead beams. During this period, the organ will also be professionally cleaned, which involves disassembly and removal of the pipes. This is an involved process that will put the organ out of commission for a number of weeks. We hope to accomplish these needed projects with a minimum of disruption and inconvenience to parishioners.

This Sunday, December 16, the candidates for the Diaconate will receive the Ministry of Lector from Bishop Campbell. Our two candidates from St. Andrew Parish, Dan Dowler and Victor Nduaguba, will be among those candidates. Congratulations to them upon reaching this stage of their formation. Beginning in January, the deacon candidates will begin training in parish assignments. Dan will be at St. Agatha and Victor at St. Timothy. Meanwhile, here at St. Andrew, we will be welcoming Chris Walsh, who hails from St. Margaret of Cortona Parish.

In this third week of Advent, let us Rejoice because the Lord is near! May God bless you all as you complete your preparations for Christmas!
