Dear Parishioners:

St. Andrew Parish will be having a Parish Mission next month on March 10-13. A parish mission is an opportunity for spiritual growth, the renewal of our conversion, the revival of our religious fervor and zeal for our faith. Our parish mission will be preached by Fr. Thomas Blau, O.P. Fr. Blau will preach at all Masses on the weekend of March 9-10. On Sunday evening, March 10, there will be a Penance Service at 6:30 p.m. to help us cleanse our hearts and consciences. Several visiting priests will be present to assist with individual Confessions. The mission itself consists of three conferences, held on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday evenings. Fr. Blau will preach on the theme of the Mass. He will help us to understand the meaning of the Mass and how we can get more out of the Mass. Each of the conferences is valuable in itself, so even if you cannot attend all three conferences, you will be inspired by and derive great benefit from each conference you take in. (Other parish activities have been suspended during those days so as to avoid interference with the mission.) 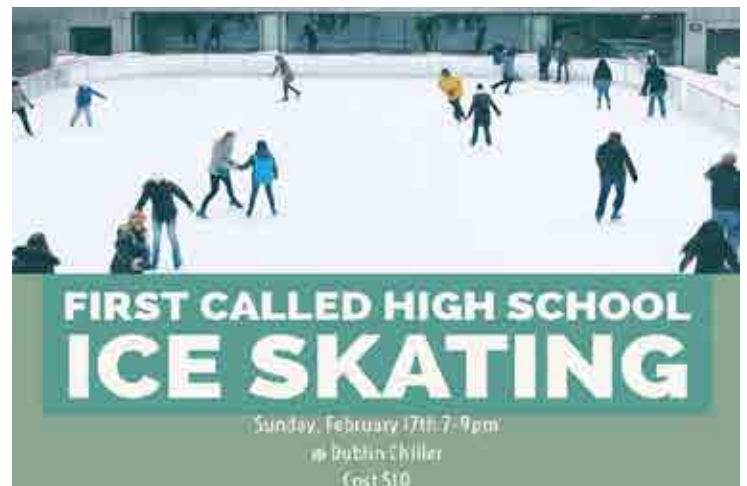

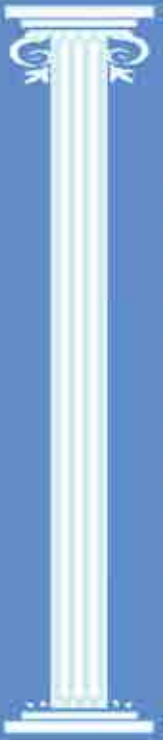
