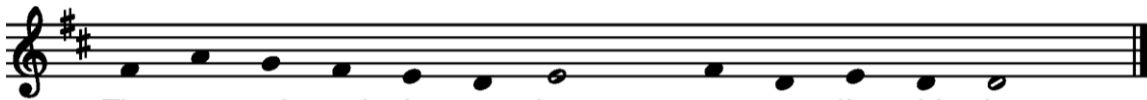

 Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.




