**PASTOR'S COLUMN**

Dear Parishioners:

Next Sunday, March 3, St. Andrew Parish will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. This year, there are 75 Confirmands in the Confirmation class. They have been catechized and prepared for this sacrament by their parents, teachers and catechists at St. Andrew School and the Parish School of Religion; they have also prepared through prayer and acts of service. The Sacrament of Confirmation is an important and significant event in the life of these young Catholics, as it marks the completion of their Christian initiation, and it imparts to them the fullness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, to enable them to live their Catholic faith fully, to witness to it, to share it with others and if necessary to defend it. Bishop Frederick Campbell will celebrate the Confirmation Mass at 3:00 p.m.

When the Bishop visits parishes on the occasion of Confirmation, he also conducts the ordinary "visitation" of the parish. Church law requires the Bishop, or his representative, to "visit" the parishes and institutions of the diocese on a regular basis. The "visitation" is a kind of inspection. The Bishop examines the sacramental registers of the parish to make sure everything is being properly recorded and the sacraments are being administered properly. He also notes the condition of the buildings and grounds, and observes the sacred furnishings and details of the liturgical celebration to insure that the regulations for the liturgy are being properly observed. I expect that St. Andrew Parish will once again pass inspection with flying colors!

Back when I was confirmed, I was taught that Confirmation makes us "soldiers of Christ." Although this imagery is not popular anymore because of the warlike emphasis, nevertheless it reminds us that the Holy Spirit empowers us to be strong and courageous Christians, ready and willing to defend our holy faith and even to lay down our lives for Christ! In order to defend our faith, of course we must first know it and understand it! The Spirit helps us to do this also, through the seven gifts of the Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge, Counsel, Piety, Fortitude, and Fear of the Lord. Please pray for our Confirmands that they may be filled with these gifts as they receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. And may all of us seek to stir into flame these same gifts which we received on the day of our own Confirmation.

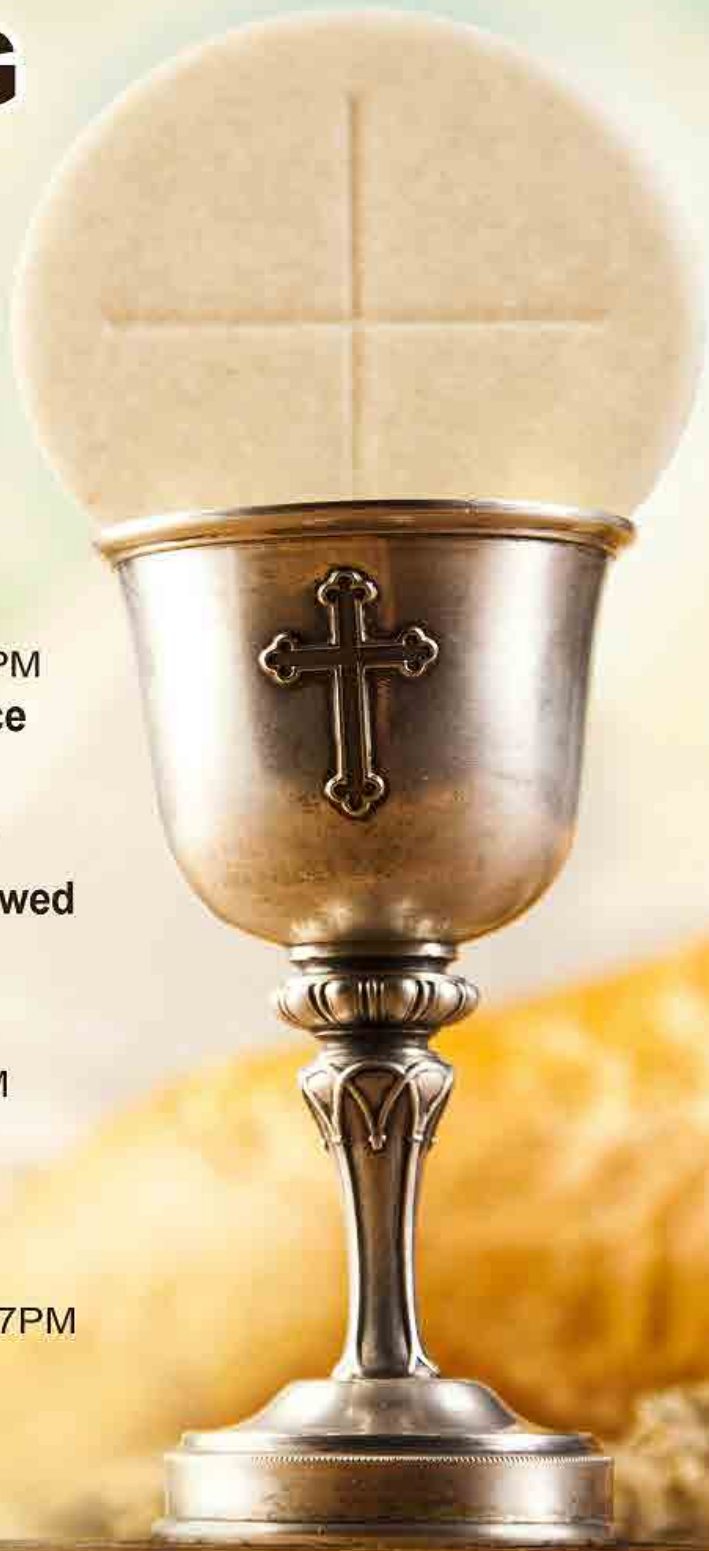
