### PASTOR'S CORNER


Dear Parishioners.

The beginning of Lent, Ash Wednesday, is less than two weeks away! I was reminiscing recently about the Church calendar back in the days before the changes of the Second Vatican Council. In the old calendar, today, two Sundays before Ash Wednesday, was known as Sexagesima Sunday. That name indicated there were approximately 60 days until Easter. I have to admit I was somewhat dismayed when I realized that Easter is only about 60 days away. How did it get to be so late? Where does the time go? It seems like just the other day was Thanksgiving. Advent, Christmas and celebrating the New Year whizzed by in a blur.

I am not ready for Lent to come, and I confess that I am not in the mood for it, at least not yet. But, ready or not, Lent will be here in ten days, so I must get ready, and so must you! I have decided, therefore, to make the most of the coming penitential season of Lent. I will rouse myself from my complacency and indifference and embrace the holy season as a pilgrimage of personal purification. I will strive to overcome my faults, to correct my bad habits and to recover my innocence. I invite you to also consider making this coming season of Lent a time of intentional purification. There are only about 60 days until Easter. We better get started, so that by the time we renew our baptismal promises on Easter Sunday, we will do so with our baptismal innocence restored! 




