MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

I've had a busy week! In fact, I didn't have time to write my weekly column. Instead, I will share with you the homily I gave to the school children at the all-school Mass on Wednesday, February 8. I hope you enjoy it...

Today, we heard from the Book of Genesis how in the beginning, God formed man out of the clay of the earth and breathed life into him. And did you notice that the very first thing that God did after He made the man was to provide food for him to eat? God planted a garden with trees in it that were delightful to look at and good for food, and the man was able to eat the fruit of all of those trees except for one. How generous God is, and how abundantly He provides food for us to eat! And not only to us human beings, but for all His creatures. The psalm today declares:


"All creatures look to you to give them food in due time. When you give it to them, they gather it; when you open your hand, they are filled with good things."

God provides us abundantly with food to eat. If you are eating your lunch in the cafeteria, or your favorite food made by your mother, or you are eating pizza or tacos or hamburgers at a restaurant, know that God is the one who provides you the food that you eat. It may have come by way of Kroger or McDonald's, or the school cafeteria or your home kitchen, but God is the giver of the food that you live on.

That is why it is so important that we thank God for our food. That's why we should pray before our meals: "Bless us, O Lord! and these Thy gifts, which we are about to receive from Thy bounty, through Christ our Lord. Amen."

EMMAUS ROAD SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Did you know there is a new tax-saving option for Ohio residents? It is called the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund and was approved last year by the State of Ohio. This is a charitable donation that actually gives you a State Tax CREDIT of up to \$1,500 for married joint filers or up to \$750 for single filers. Keep in mind the credit is worth much more than a deduction. The credit reduces your tax liability dollar-for-dollar. A deduction simply reduces your taxable income.

Contributions can be made using the Diocese of Columbus' Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund link where you can direct your contribution directly to St. Andrew School tuition assistance. Any Ohio State Tax Payer can participate. You can also use this contribution as a federal tax deduction. The tax savings can be substantial.



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! This Tuesday is a special day. It will be St. Valentine's Day. That's right! St. Valentine was a priest who lived way back in the 200s and who died for his brave witness for the



Christian faith. It's not clear how it happened over the centuries, but his feast day (February 14) eventually became associated with the topic of love.

St. Valentine's Day is a good chance to meow about... errrr...to think about what true love really is. There are lots of kinds of love, like the love between friends, the love between you and your family members (yes, even your brothers and sisters), and the special love shared only by your mom and dad. But all these kinds of love have one thing in common: they all seek what is good for the other person.

Would it be a good thing if "friends" or siblings or mom and dad were to be mean to each other and see each other simply as a way to "get only what you want"? Of course not. Real love means wanting what's good for another person, even if it might require some hard work and sacrifice on your part.

As a cat, I know that Father really loves me because he does the hard work of feeding me, changing my litter, and caring for me whenever I am sick. Those are not always fun things to do, but they show me his authentic love. And there is a joy and a special bond that arises from knowing that someone else cares for me that much.
