MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Back in the Fall, I wrote some commentary about changing attitudes toward Baptism, and at the time, I stated I would follow up from time to time about other practices and attitudes surrounding Catholic sacraments and rites. Today, I am going to offer some comments about funerals in the Catholic Church.

Perhaps the biggest change in attitude over the last few decades is in regard to cremation. Before the Revised Code of Canon Law was issued in 1983, cremation was forbidden. Once it was permitted, cremation has grown in popularity. It seems to me that one out of every three funerals I officiate is a cremation. However, the church still prefers traditional burial ("in humation") because Our Lord Jesus Christ was buried in a tomb, from which He rose again from the dead. At the Funeral Mass, great honor is shown to the body of the deceased, but this is difficult to do with cremated remains. The church's law insists that, while cremation is permissible, it may never be chosen for reasons contrary to the faith. The funeral rites and church law also insist that bodies are to be buried, preferably in a Catholic cemetery, or at least in a blessed grave. A Catholic cemetery is a sacred place and is solemnly dedicated similar to a church. Cremated remains are also to be buried or entombed in a blessed cemetery or grave. They should never be scattered, divided up, or kept at home.

There are three parts or "stations" of the Catholic funeral rites: the vigil for the deceased, the Funeral Mass (with final commendation), and the Committal. In recent years, I have observed that the vigil for the deceased, which usually takes place at the funeral home the day or evening before the funeral Mass, has fallen into disuse, and most funerals omit the vigil altogether.

The funeral rites of the Catholic Church are designed to remind us that our deceased loved ones have been baptized into the paschal mystery of Christ, and those who have died with Christ will also rise with Him. This should be the emphasis rather than merely a "celebration of life" or eulogizing the deceased.

that many of you have heard our new handbells, there will be several opportunities to try them out and see if this ensemble might be a good fit for you. Attendance at an introductory session carries no


obligation to join the Handbell Choir. No previous ringing experience is necessary, but a basic knowledge of music reading is helpful.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! During these long winter days when we're stuck inside so much, I try to find interesting things to do. Life is too exciting to waste it on video games all day long. There's a



whole world to discover! One interesting area that Father Ferguson has been introducing me to is that of fine music. That's right! Talented musicians can make great music on instruments like violins, pianos, and trumpets. Have you ever heard those instruments played?

Father recently told me about a couple of instances when cats – yes, cats! – actually helped compose, or write, fine music. Who knew? Back in the 1700s, a musician in Italy named Domenico Scarlatti had a cat. And one day, his cat walked up and down the keyboard of his harpsichord (kind of like a piano). Scarlatti paid attention to the sounds his cat produced, and he made those sounds the "theme" of a special piece of music called a "fugue." A fugue is when you play a theme several different ways. Well, Scarlatti's new piece of music became known as the "Cat's Fugue"! It's also known as the Sonata in G Minor. See if your parents can find it on the internet! Can you pick out the theme sounds that the cat made?*

Much more recently, in the 1990s, another cat named Ketzel was owned by a composer named Moshe Cotel in New York City. One day, Ketzel jumped up on Cotel's piano, and with its paws, made some sounds. Cotel wrote down exactly what Ketzel composed – it lasted about 20 seconds – and entered the composition into a contest for musical pieces lasting less than one minute. It was called "Piece for Piano: Four Paws." And you know what? Ketzel won "Honorable Mention"! It's a much different style than Scarlatti's cat, but it shows that interesting music can come in all forms. ** Why not spend some time this week when you're indoors and explore all the wonderful kinds of music that God has inspired humans – and cats – to create? Have a "purr"-fect week!

EMMAUS ROAD SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Did you know there is **a new tax saving option** for Ohio residents? It is called the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund and was approved last year by the State of Ohio. This is a charitable donation that actually gives you a State Tax CREDIT of up to \$1,500 for married joint filers or up to \$750 for single filers. Keep in mind the credit is worth much more than a deduction. The credit reduces your tax liability dollar-for-dollar. A deduction simply reduces your taxable income.

Contributions can be made using the Diocese of Columbus' Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund link where you can direct your contribution directly to St. Andrew School tuition assistance. Any Ohio State Tax Payer can participate. You can also use this contribution as a federal tax deduction. The tax savings can be substantial.




