MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend is the kickoff of "The Appeal 2023." This is the campaign to support the ministries and services of the Diocese of Columbus that was formerly known as the Bishop's Annual Appeal. The name has been changed to The Appeal to emphasize how important this campaign is to our local church. It is not just another request for a charitable contribution to an organization that does good works. All of us receive many of these requests and donate to them generously. But this appeal is more important than the rest – it is "the" Appeal because the life and vitality and future of our church depend on it.
