MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, or the Feast of Corpus Christi. This Feast reminds us that Jesus Christ is truly and really present in the most Blessed Sacrament, and He remains present, truly and substantially, in the consecrated bread, which is His Body, reserved in the tabernacle. This is the fulfillment of Jesus' promise to His disciples in Matthew 28: "Behold I am with you always until the end of the age." Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist, and the sanctuary lamp, which burns near the tabernacle, is the reminder of His presence. Not only do we receive His true Body and Blood in the Holy Communion, but He is present with us always, to be honored, adored and worshipped by believers.

The Feast of Corpus Christi this year is also the focus of the Eucharistic Revival that is taking place across our nation. This year, the focus is on eucharistic revival in the local parish. Truthfully, our faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist needs to be revived. Many Catholics tend to forget this fundamental truth, which they believed, understood and accepted at the time they made their First Communion. They begin to doubt this truth, or to regard the Eucharist as just a symbol of Christ's presence. This may lead to receiving the Body of Christ in Holy Communion in a perfunctory and careless way, without awareness or preparation, perhaps even unworthily if one is not in the state of grace. We can learn from our First Communicants as we observe these children receiving Communion so reverently and with such care and devotion – they know that Jesus is truly present and giving Himself to them as their spiritual food. As part of the national Eucharistic Revival, I hope to bring about a renewed faith and reverence for the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. To this end, I ask each of you to do the following:

- Come to Mass at least every Sunday and receive Holy Communion if you are eligible and properly disposed to do so.
- Show reverence for the Blessed Sacrament by genuflecting or making a profound bow before entering your pew or when crossing in front of the sanctuary/tabernacle.
- Prepare for Holy Communion by observing the eucharistic fast of one hour before receiving and offering thanksgiving after receiving. If you have committed grave sins, you must be absolved in the Sacrament of Reconciliation (confession) before receiving Communion.
- Make a visit to the church to make a "holy hour" with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. In particular, come to adore Jesus during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament held every Tuesday in the church from 6:00-9:00 p.m. I would love to see more people participate in this eucharistic devotion, which concludes with Night Prayer (Compline) and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 8:45 p.m.
- Take a copy of Bishop Barron's book "This is My Body," and read it. Take a second one and give it to a friend. A generous parishioner has donated these books to St. Andrew Parish for free distribution to all. This book is intended to restore belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist especially among Catholics whose faith has grown weak. These books are available this weekend in the vestibule and other areas of the church. Please take and read this book and help promote the Eucharistic Revival!

June is also the month of the Sacred Heart. So I conclude my message today with this prayer, which is very much in keeping with the goal of the Eucharistic Revival and the Feast of Corpus Christi. "May the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the altar be praised, honored and adored in all the tabernacles of the world, even to the end of time!

The law effectively gives you the power to direct your tax dollars to support Our Catholic Schools' efforts to lead children to an encounter with Jesus Christ and change lives.

It's a win-win for all involved if you pay taxes to the State of Ohio – and you probably do!

Can this Tax Credit Benefit You?

Every person's situation is unique but, if your year-over-year tax circumstances haven't changed significantly, you may be eligible to receive the tax credit by making a contribution to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund. 




