MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Thanks to all who participated in our Corpus Christi procession last Sunday at the conclusion of the 11:00 a.m. Mass. I was extremely pleased with the reverent participation of nearly the entire congregation. It was only a short procession, but it was so important because it was the first time such a procession had been attempted at St. Andrew in a very long time. One parishioner mentioned that she has belonged to St. Andrew since 1992 and could not remember ever having a Corpus Christi procession. So, I am happy that we have established this tradition and in doing so, brought the Eucharistic Revival to St. Andrew Parish.

This coming week, there is a convocation for all priests of the diocese at Salt Fork State Park in the vicinity of Cambridge, Ohio. The convocation begins Monday afternoon, June 19, and ends on Thursday, June 22, at Noon. Bishop Fernandes expects all the priests to participate in this important convocation. Please be aware that the priests of St. Andrew Parish will be participating in this convocation, and therefore, will be away from the parish for these days. Please also be aware that, because of this, there will be **NO DAILY MASSES** on Tuesday, June 20, Wednesday, June 21, and Thursday, June 22. During these days, the priests will not be available for sacramental emergencies or funerals. There will still be Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesday evening from 6:00-9:00 p.m., and the church will be open during the usual hours for those who wish to come and pray.

I hope you will pray for all the priests attending the convocation, especially for your St. Andrew priests!

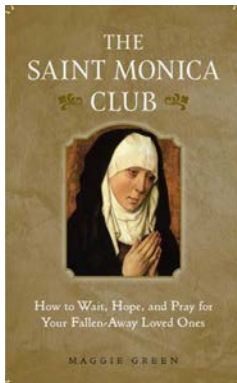

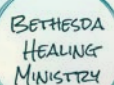
