MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

DID YOU KNOW THAT THE CHURCH OF YOUR BAPTISM KEEPS YOUR SACRAMENTAL RECORDS?

When a child is Baptized, they are entered into the current Baptism Register book. The entry includes the child's full name, date of birth, place of birth, Baptism date, parents' names, Godparents' names, and the name of the celebrant.

When that person receives the Sacraments of Confirmation, Matrimony, or Holy Orders, a notice is sent to the church of Baptism. The church of Baptism updates the person's record to properly reflect the new Sacrament with the date and place of the event. More recently parishes have been recording First Communion in the Baptism Register, although they are not required to do so by Canon Law.

These books are incredibly special and important to the Church. They are kept in a fireproof safe behind a fireproof door. They are not permitted to leave the property. Because they contain information that is personal and confidential, they are private documents, not public ones. No one other than the pastor or his delegate can claim a right to the direct access to the registers.

Here are a few facts about the Baptism Register at St. Andrew:

- On July 17, 1955, the first Baptism at St. Andrew Parish took place.
- St. Andrew is on its fourth book of Baptism Registers.
- As of June 18, 2023, 6,812 people have been Baptized at St. Andrew Parish.

A parish will ask for proof of Baptism when you want to receive a sacrament such as Confirmation, Matrimony or Holy Orders. Or, you may need Baptism records if you are asked to be a godparent or confirmation sponsor.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. As I am sure you've all been doing, I've been enjoying summer vacation, too! Summer is a chance to get out of the house and explore all kinds of new experiences. Father Ferguson was just on his vacation, and he told me that some of the things he did were to go to history museums and antique shops and to learn more about life in the past. That's right! 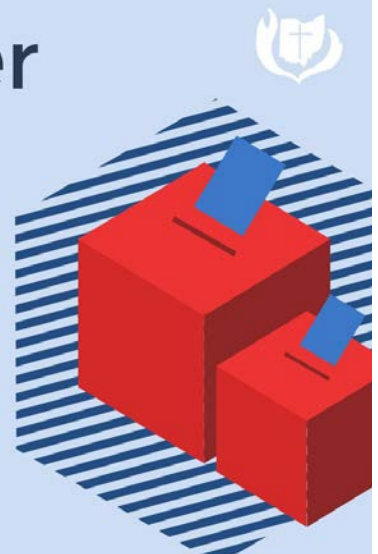
