MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Recently, Bishop Fernandes announced his decisions for the restructuring of our diocesan parishes, bringing to a conclusion the strategic planning process known as "Real Presence, Real Future." I hope that you have checked out this information and learned the details of the plans to better use the resources of the diocese, and utilize our priests, You may have noticed that the recommendations approved by the Bishop call for St. Andrew Parish and St. Timothy Parish to merge into one parish at some point in the future, but to maintain two sites and two schools. I do not know what the timeline will be for the implementation of this plan, but I believe it is not likely to occur for several years. There are more urgent matters to be addressed. To be honest, I hope that the implementation of this plan would be something the next pastor of St. Andrew Parish will deal with rather than me! I will reach retirement age in 2026. While I will do whatever is asked of me, my hope is that this merger will not go into effect until at least that time.

I am pleased to announce that Bishop Fernandes has appointed Fr. Lawrence Tabi, a priest of the Diocese of Obuasi, Ghana (West Africa), as a part-time Parochial Vicar of St. Andrew Parish effective July 11, 2023. Fr. Tabi will also serve as the Parochial Administrator of St. Aloysius Parish in the Hilltop neighborhood of Columbus and will be the pastoral leader for the Ghanaian Catholic Community. Fr. Tabi will reside here at St. Andrew, and as part of his assignment, will do hospital ministry at Riverside one day a week. I have not yet met Fr. Tabi, but he has obtained his visa and completed all other immigration requirements, so I look forward to meeting him soon and collaborating with him in ministry at St. Andrew Parish. Because Fr. Tabi will be ministering to the Ghanaian Catholic Community, his availability on Sundays

at St. Andrew will be limited. Fr. Paul Noble, who is in residence at St. Andrew and serves as Chaplain at Bishop Watterson High School, will also be seen more frequently as a celebrant at daily and Sunday Masses at St. Andrew beginning in July. Fr. Ferguson is preparing for his move to St. Mary Parish in Delaware. I am grateful for his pastoral assistance at St. Andrew Parish over the last three years. His last weekend here will be July 8-9, and you will have an opportunity to whish him well at that time.

Next weekend (June 10-11) is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as the Feast of Corpus Christi. It is a custom to have a Eucharistic Procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi; however, this has not been practiced at St. Andrew for a long time. In an effort to promote the Eucharistic revival in our parish, I thought we should bring back this custom of a Eucharistic procession. Therefore, next Sunday, June 11, the 11:00 a.m. Mass will conclude with the exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament, and a short procession from the church out the northwest doors, along Reed Road to Churchview, and ending at the steps of St. Andrew School. The congregation will be invited to join the procession, and at the conclusion, Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament will be given. I predict this will add only 15 minutes to the time of the Mass.

I hope that this act of devotion to the body of Christ in the Eucharist will result in more fervent awareness and Adoration of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist all year long!




