MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This past Tuesday, July 11, was "moving day" in the Diocese of Columbus, as all of the priests with new assignments moved in to them. Here at St. Andrew Parish, Fr. Lawrence Tabi, our new Parochial Vicar, also moved in and began his ministry to our parish. I hope you will give him a warm welcome.

It occurred to me that I moved in to St. Andrew Parish on moving day 2013. That means I have been pastor here for a full ten years now! How quickly the years go by! St. Andrew is a wonderful parish and I enjoy being here and pastoring this parish. In those years, I have been greatly assisted by the priests who have been assigned as parochial vicars. Fr. Tabi is the fifth one to be assigned during my pastorate, and I am grateful for his assistance. And, of course, Fr. DeVille continues to provide abundant and faithful service as he has done for many years. These priests make my job so much easier. I look forward to a few more years as pastor of St. Andrew!

I want to thank all those who have contributed or pledged to "The Appeal 2023." We are closing in on our goal, and because of your generous response, I believe we will soon reach our goal. One of the great things about The Appeal is that any contributions over and above our goal will be refunded to the parish. I am hoping that we can significantly surpass our goal this year, because St. Andrew Parish could really benefit from a substantial refund. We need to replace a failing chiller that serves the school building. With approval of our Finance Council and the diocese, we are proceeding with this project. Because of supply issues and inflation, the total cost of this project will be more than \$600,000. This will have to be paid from our parish reserves, but it is a huge "hit" to them. I would love to replenish our reserves with a refund from The Appeal.

I recently sent a letter to parishioners encouraging you to contribute to The Appeal if you have not already done so, and I hope you will do just that. I have learned that some parishioners who already contributed also received this letter. That wasn't my intention, so if you have already pledged to The Appeal, please know of my gratitude, and disregard the letter. As always, thanks to all of you for your support.



FROM THE DESK OF FR. TABI

Dear St. Andrew Parishioners.

My name is Fr. Lawrence Tabi, and I am the new Parochial Vicar assigned to St. Andrew Parish. I am blessed to be here and ready to serve St. Andrew, as well as St. Aloysius Church as Administrator and Chaplain for the Ghanaian Catholic Community.



Born and raised in Kantinkyiren in the Ashanti Region of Ghana, West Africa, I was the eighth child in a family of 10. I did not come from a Catholic background, but, while attending mission school as a young student, I was exposed to the Catholic faith and through the grace of God, I discovered my vocation. I later entered the St. Hubert Minor Seminary in Kumasi, Ashanti. I am proud to share that since my conversion to the Catholic faith and formation, my family - including my parents (now deceased) and all living siblings - converted to Catholicism, as well!

Here's a little bit of information about my background: I completed seminary formation at St. Peter's Regional Seminary, Cape Coast, Ghana, and was ordained to the Catholic Priesthood on July 13, 1991. I also hold a Bachelor of Theology from the University of Ghana, and a Master of Arts in Pastoral Counseling from the Athenaeum of Ohio. It was during my studies at the Athenaeum that I met Bishop Earl Fernandes, who was a seminarian at the time.

Since my ordination, I've served parishes in the United States and West Africa, most recently at St. John the Baptist Parish, New Edubiase. In the US, I was located in Cincinnati and was "in residence" at Our Lord Christ the King Church.

I look forward to learning more about you all and the rich traditions you've built within this vibrant, faithfilled Catholic community. I hope to share with you the traditions of the African culture and the mutual love we all have for our Catholic faith!

God bless you, and let us pray for one another.

RCIA WILL KICK-OFF THIS FALL: Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process through which non-baptized men and women enter the Catholic Church. It includes several stages marked by study, prayer, and rites at Mass. Participants in the RCIA are known as catechumens. They undergo a conversion process as they study the Gospel, profess faith in Jesus and the Catholic Church, and receive the sacraments of Christan Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Eucharist. The RCIA process follows the ancient practice of the Church and was restored by the Second Vatican Council as the proper way adults prepare for Baptism.




