# MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

By now, you are aware that Issue 1 was passed by Ohio voters on Election Day, November 7, and that the Ohio Constitution is therefore amended to include abortion rights and other reproductive rights. This is not the outcome we hoped for, and that we worked and prayed for. Nevertheless, we must continue our efforts to protect and defend all human life, from conception to natural death, above all by converting hearts and minds with gentle persuasion and persistent witness. Let us not give up our efforts or our hope.

I thought I would continue to share some thoughts from the parish survey from earlier this year. I have already told you how I have personally read all the surveys and, with the help of Parish Council, staff members and volunteers, I have begun to implement some of the suggestions that were made. Some suggestions were things that needed to be addressed and steps needed to be taken to address them. A good example is the sound quality of the public address system in the church. We have already improved the effectiveness of the sound system by reducing the fan speed of the heating and air-conditioning system, thus reducing the background noise. Many parishioners have told me they have noticed the improvement!

The survey also revealed that many parishioners have difficulties and struggles with some teachings of the Catholic faith itself. Some of the suggestions made are not within my power to change. For example, "We should have married priests," or "We should ordain women as priests." I am grateful that these thoughts were expressed, and I hope to find ways to address these concerns pastorally and help individuals through their struggles and difficulties while remaining in communion with the church.

I will continue to consider all of the survey responses and update you from time-to-time on implementation. Thank you again for your participation and your honest responses. May God bless you all, and may the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace!


