## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

On Thursday of this week, we observe Thanksgiving Day, a national holiday dedicated to giving thanks to God. Thanksgiving Day Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday. As usual, I will be celebrating the holiday with my brother and two sisters in my hometown of Ada, Ohio. I will also offer the Mass on Thanksgiving Day at my home parish of Our Lady of Lourdes in Ada. Since I will be away from St. Andrew for Thanksgiving, I will take this opportunity to wish all of you a Happy Thanksgiving! I am especially thankful for all of the parishioners of St. Andrew and for the privilege of pastoring this congregation.

There are several opportunities coming up that I want to remind you about. More details about these are found elsewhere in this bulletin, but I want to highlight these for you also.

First, Tuesday, Nov. 28, is "Giving Tuesday." This is the day set aside to promote giving to a variety of causes. St. Andrew Parish has participated for several years and we are doing so again this year. Our hope is to raise money for needed improvements and updates in Nugent Parish Hall, our main social hall in the lower level of the church. I hope you will consider supporting this on Giving Tuesday and that we succeed in raising the needed funds.

Second, I want to invite and urge you to attend our parish mission on Tuesday, Dec. 6, at 7:00 p.m. in the church. We are excited to have Dr. Edward Sri live and in person here at St. Andrew to present "An Evening on the Eucharist." This fits in with our emphasis on the Eucharistic Revival. Please plan to attend this event.

Finally, I want to ask you to come and hear U.S. Army Brigadier General Mark Arnold (Ret.) speak about his project, *Frontline Medical Ukraine Fund*, a charity that supports training of medics in Ukraine to reduce the needless deaths and amputations among injured soldiers as a result of improper medical treatment. This project has received much support and praise, including from Bishop Fernandes. Because Mark is our fellow parishioner, we should get behind him and support him! I hope you will come on Monday, Dec. 11, at 7:00 p.m. in the parish hall to hear about this project and to learn more about the situation in Ukraine.

Let us give thanks to the Lord for all His blessings!

## An Evening with U.S. Army Brigadier General Mark Arnold (Ret.)

All parishioners and community members are invited to this special evening of awareness and learning led by fellow parishioner, General Mark Arnold.

After retiring from the U.S. Army, General Arnold made the transition to firefighter and EMT and wanted to lend his skills in emergency medical services toward helping Ukrainians. He began volunteering in Ukraine, providing training to medics on the frontlines of the crisis. In March 2023, General Arnold established the *Frontline Medical Ukraine Fund* at The Columbus Foundation to help continue providing medical training and supplies, saving the lives of Ukrainian soldiers and civilians alike.

General Arnold will share his story of service, how he became inspired to help those who help others and how parishioners and their guests can contribute to this extraordinary fund that helps support the education and operations of medics and first-line critical care providers in Ukraine.

## GIVING TUESDAY

**We are a few weeks away from this global day of giving!** When we participated in GIVING TUESDAY last year – through your generosity – we raised more than \$20,000 for needed improvements to the Bryce Eck Activity Center. With that money, we replaced the chairs, refrigerator, and ice machine and made additional improvements throughout the building! This year, we are turning our fundraising efforts toward Nugent Parish Hall.

**OUR NEED:** With more than 20 years of wear and tear in the parish hall – using the space for classrooms, annual parish and diocesan events, banquets, and receptions – the equipment and fixtures are in disrepair and must be replaced. We need a new gas range, warming cabinets, and a chest freezer. In addition, most of the round tables need to be replaced. Money in excess of our goal will go toward new carpeting, upgraded LED lighting, and dehumidification for the space.

In addition to Christmas Eve and Day Masses, this scheduling period includes a Holy Day of Obligation, the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, with a Vigil Mass at 7 p.m. on Thursday, Dec. 7, and Masses at 6:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m. (all-school Mass) and 12:15 p.m.

Please note that Christmas Vigil and Christmas Day Altar Servers and Lectors will be scheduled separately and names placed into the scheduler once determined. Christmas Vigil Mass times are 4:00 p.m. (one in the church and one in the parish hall), 6 p.m. (church), and 10 p.m. (church), and Christmas Day Mass times are 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. (church).

The Solemnity of Mary on January 1 is not a Holy Day of Obligation and there will be no Vigil Mass on Dec. 31, 2023. On January 1, 2024, there will be two Masses, 9 a.m. and 11 a.m.

Dear Parishioners,

I am pleased to present to you the summary Parish Financial Report (next page) for fiscal year 2022-2023 ending June 20, 2023. It is important for all parishioners to be aware of the financial condition of the parish.

Our Mass attendance has not yet recovered to prepandemic levels, and therefore, we budgeted our predicted offertory income conservatively. Nevertheless, St. Andrew Parish continues to be financially solvent, thanks, above all, to the generosity and stewardship of our parishioners. For this, I am deeply grateful.

You may have noticed it mentioned elsewhere in this bulletin that the parish has exceeded our goal for The Appeal 2023. Next year, both The Appeal goal and the diocesan assessment rate will be increased, and if The Appeal goal is not met, the remainder will be added to the assessment. Simply put, this means our obligations to the diocese will be increasing significantly in the future and we must plan to fulfill those obligations.

Also, because of the much-needed chiller replacement in the school cafeteria area, our reserves are being reduced. This project will cost more than \$600,000, and we will need to replenish these reserves at some point.

Finally, inflation has driven up costs and expenses, especially for utilities. As costs and expenditures rise, we must find revenue to meet these expenses.

We ended fiscal year 2022-2023 in a relatively good position. As we look to the future, we must seek to strengthen that position further in order to meet increasing challenges.

Again, I am grateful for your generous support of St. Andrew Parish!

#### NOTES:

- For fiscal year 2022-23, total parish operating revenue increased over prior year but was outpaced by overall higher expenses.
- Offertory increased by 4.7% over prior year and 5.7% better than budget.
- Utility usage remained relatively consistent year over year, however, rate increases created higher expense for all facilities.
- Salary and benefits came in higher than prior year driven by mix of increased staff, salary increases, and higher group health costs.
- Other Revenue and expenditures were consistent with prior year.
- School enrollment (420 students) remained consistent to prior year and is expected to reach 440 in 2023-24.
