MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the second Sunday of Advent already! Christmas Eve is just two weeks away! The season of Advent is very short this year – only three weeks and a day from beginning to end. And the fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Sunday, Dec. 24.

The morning Masses on December 24 are celebrated for the fourth Sunday of Advent. The Masses after 4:00 p.m. on the 24th are Christmas Masses. Catholics have an obligation to attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. The obligation is fulfilled by attending any Mass on the day itself or the evening before (like the Vigil Mass). Even though these days fall in close succession this year, there is an obligation to be fulfilled for both the fourth Sunday of Advent and the Solemnity of Christmas.

Of special note, there will be no 11:00 a.m. Mass on the fourth Sunday of Advent (Sunday, Dec. 24). We made this decision for several reasons, including:

- 1. We need to prepare the church for the Christmas Masses in the afternoon.
- 2. Historically, when the fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Christmas Eve, the Sunday morning Masses are poorly attended, and some people inevitably, but wrongly, expect the late morning Mass to be an "early" Christmas Mass.
- 3. Priests are limited in the number of Masses they are allowed to celebrate in a 24-hour period.

For all these reasons, we decided to adjust the Mass schedule and omit the Sunday 11:00 a.m. Mass on December 24.

Thanks to all who attended the Parish Mission on December 6 and helped to make it a success. I hope and pray that we will all continue to grow in our awareness of and reverence for the Presence of Jesus Christ with us in the Most Holy Eucharist.

May God bless you all in these days of Advent and may we be ready to meet Christ the Lord when we celebrate His birth at Christmas!

JOIN NEEDS YOUR HELP!

JOIN (Joint Organization for Inner-City Needs) is often a "stop-gap" for our brothers and sisters who are doing their best to provide and succeed in life. We all come upon unexpected obstacles. For our neighbors who live paycheck to paycheck that can be something as simple as missing work due to illness or a car repair. Basic supplies like toilet paper, soap, shampoo, conditioner, multi-purpose cleaning solutions, dish soap and laundry soap are items that people request at JOIN daily. For example, Kelsey, a young mom, came to JOIN to get assistance with bus passes for a new job she had. When she learned that we also had cleaning supplies and personal care items, especially toilet paper, she was overwhelmed that she could get those items as well. Meeting these most basic needs, when you don't have them, is a relief that is not measurable to a parent. Try to imagine running out of something, with no hope of getting it yourself for another week or so.

Turn Your Taxes into Scholarships for Catholic Education

Thanks to a state law passed in 2021, Ohio taxpayers now are eligible to receive a tax credit for qualified donations to our scholarship granting organization (SGO), the **Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund!** Donors receive a dollar-for-dollar credit (not deduction) on their Ohio income tax liability of up to \$750 or \$1,500 if married, filing jointly.

Why? The Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund was established to help make an authentic Catholic education affordable and accessible for all families in our Catholic Diocese of Columbus.





The law effectively gives you the power to direct your tax dollars to support Our Catholic Schools' efforts to lead children to an encounter with Jesus Christ and change lives.

It's a win-win for all involved if you pay taxes to the State of Ohio – and you probably do!

Can this Tax Credit Benefit You?

Every person's situation is unique but, if your year-over-year tax circumstances haven't changed significantly, you may be eligible to receive the tax credit by making a contribution to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund. The easiest place to start is by reviewing your most recent Ohio Income Tax Return. Then, follow these three, easy steps.

1 Pull your prior year return

The form you'll need to review is **Ohio IT 1040**.

2 Review line 8c on page 2

This is your total income tax liability *before credits*, or what the state says you owe as a taxpayer.

Is line 10 greater than \$0.00?

If so, you can reduce this liability on a dollar-for-dollar basis with a gift to the Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund, up to \$750 or \$1,500 if married and filing jointly.


