MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

As Christmas Day dawns in this year of Our Lord 2023, we once again recall and celebrate the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ. "For us men and for our salvation, He came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man." This is the one whom Isaiah foretold would be called, "Wonder-counselor, God-hero, Father-forever, and Prince of Peace," and "whose dominion is vast and forever peaceful." (Is 9:5) When He was born, we are told "the whole world was at peace," (*Christmas Proclamation from the Roman Martyrology*) and angels heralded His birth singing, "Glory to God in the highest! Peace on earth, goodwill to men." (Lk 2:14)

This Christmas 2023, the whole world is not at peace. Wars are being fought around the world in places like Ukraine and Gaza. Conflicts and violence abound. Even Bethlehem, the place of Jesus' birth, is not the peaceful "little town" we sing about in Christmas carols. There are no church decorations or public celebration in Manger Square in Bethlehem this year, because there is no peace.

In spite of this, we must not give in to despair or hopelessness. Jesus Christ was born to save His people from their sins. He told his disciples on the night before he died: "Peace I leave you. My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled." (Jn 14:27)

My sincere and fervent prayer for each and every one of you this Christmas is that Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace, will bestow His peace upon you, that you may know and experience the peace in your heart, mind and soul, and that no circumstance of loss, misfortune, illness or calamity will rob you of that peace that surpasses all understanding.

I wish all of you a most blessed and joyous Christmas! May the Peace of the Lord be with you always!

Have you considered Bible Study? Interested in an overview of the Bible? Join the Tuesday Evening Bible Study as we dive into questions about the Bible, where it comes from, and its purpose.

Genesis to Jesus is a 12-part Bible Study series that surveys the principal covenants that God made with his people through figures such as Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses, and David. It also shows how each of these covenants points forward to, and is fulfilled by, Jesus Christ and His Church. Learn the basic Catholic principles for reading Scripture and survey the broad outlines of the books of the Bible and their place in the story of salvation.

Each week begins with a short video followed by small group discussion. The discussion will wrap up in time to attend Adoration/Benediction.

Optional individual study is available through the purchase of the workbook. If you choose to purchase the workbook, there is a participant guide (includes access to stream the videos for four months) and a leader guide. (with answers to the study questions, but does not include access to streamed videos.) 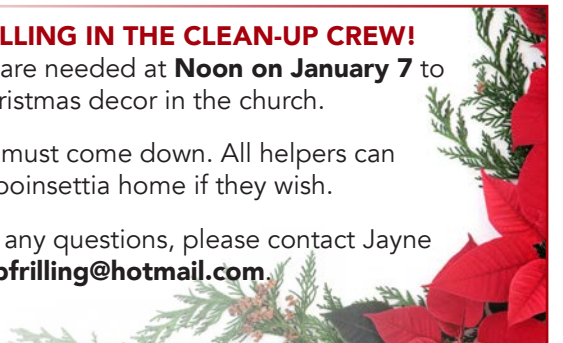


WE'RE CALLING IN THE CLEAN-UP CREW!

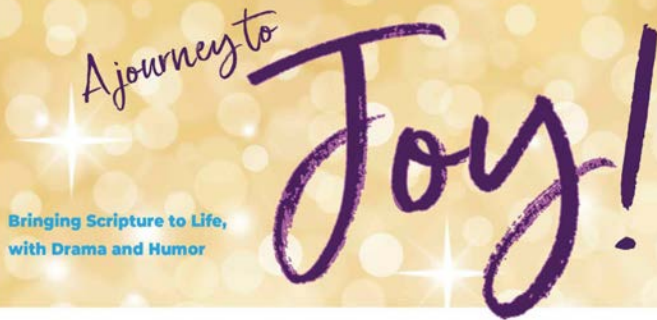

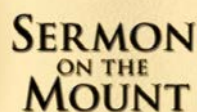

JOIN (Joint Organization for Inner-City Needs) is often a "stop-gap" for our brothers and sisters who are doing their best to provide and succeed in life. We all come upon unexpected obstacles. For our neighbors who live paycheck to paycheck that can be something as simple as missing work due to illness or a car repair. Basic supplies like toilet paper, soap, shampoo, conditioner, multi-purpose cleaning solutions, dish soap and laundry soap are items that people request at JOIN daily. For example, "Kelsey," a young mom, came to JOIN to get assistance with bus passes for a new job. When she learned that we had cleaning supplies and personal care items, especially toilet paper, she was overwhelmed that she could get those items as well. Meeting these most basic needs, when you don't have them, is a relief that is not measurable to a parent. Try to imagine running out of something, with no hope of getting it yourself for another week or so.
