MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today, we begin the holy season of Advent as we begin a new church year with the First Sunday of Advent.

The word "advent" means "coming." The season of Advent recalls the first coming of our Savior and Lord Jesus Christ who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. The season of Advent also prepares us for His "Second Coming," when He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. As we say at Mass, we "await the blessed hope and the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

In between the first and the second coming of Christ the Savior, there is another coming: The Lord Jesus Christ has given us the Eucharist, the sacrament of His Body and Blood, so that He is present to us and with us all our days as we make our pilgrim way in this world. He comes to us in every celebration of the Mass, and He gives Himself to us as our food. During this season of Advent, I hope that you will look for His coming, especially in the Holy Eucharist, for He truly comes to you personally and powerfully and is really and substantially present to you in His Body and Blood, which you receive in Holy Communion.

It is this awareness of the presence and power of Christ that the Eucharistic Revival is meant to promote. I hope you will all attend our parish mission on December 6, where Dr. Edward Sri will speak to us about the Holy Eucharist. This is a wonderful opportunity to deepen our awareness and appreciation of Christ's true presence.

I also want to remind you that retired U.S. Army Brigadier General (and St. Andrew Parishioner) Mark Arnold will be speaking on Monday, Dec. 11, at 7:00 p.m. in the Parish Hall to inform us about the dire situation in Ukraine and to invite your support for his efforts to save lives and limbs of the wounded soldiers through better training of medics. Please plan to attend this speaking event and give support to our fellow parishioner and his cause.

I wish you all a Happy Advent! Come Lord Jesus!

An Evening with U.S. Army Brigadier General Mark Arnold (Ret.)

Monday, Dec. 11 • 7:00 p.m. • Nugent Parish Hall

All parishioners are invited to this special evening of awareness and learning led by **fellow parishioner General Mark Arnold**.

Russia's invasion of Ukraine has sparked a large-scale humanitarian disaster resulting in thousands of casualties among Ukrainian soldiers and civilians, as well as millions more being displaced from their homes. As General Arnold watched the invasion first unfold in early 2022, he jumped into action, collecting medical supplies to send to Ukrainians on the frontlines.

For General Arnold, it was the logical course of action: after retiring from the U.S. Army, he became a firefighter and EMT and wanted to lend his skills in emergency medical services toward helping Ukrainians. Soon after, General Arnold began volunteering in Ukraine, providing training to medics on the frontlines of the crisis. In March 2023, General Arnold established the Frontline Medical Ukraine Fund at The Columbus Foundation to help continue providing medical training and supplies, saving the lives of Ukrainian soldiers and civilians alike. General Arnold will share his story of service, how he became inspired to help Ukrainian soldiers and civilians impacted by this war, and how parishioners and their guests can contribute to this extraordinary fund that helps support the education and operations of medics and first-line critical care providers in Ukraine.
