GENESIS TO JESUS

Have you considered Bible Study? Interested in an overview of the Bible? Join the Tuesday Evening Bible Study as we dive into questions about the Bible, where it comes from, and its purpose.

Genesis to Jesus is a 12-part Bible Study series that surveys the principal covenants that God made with His people through figures such as Adam, Noah, Abraham, Moses, and David. It also shows how each of these covenants points forward to, and is fulfilled by, Jesus Christ and His Church. Learn the basic Catholic principles for reading Scripture and survey the broad outlines of the books of the Bible and their place in the story of salvation.

Each week begins with a short video, followed by small group discussion. The discussion will wrap up in time to attend Adoration/Benediction.

Optional individual study is available through the purchase of the workbook. If you choose to purchase the workbook, there is a participant guide (includes access to stream the videos for four months) and a leader guide (with answers to the study questions, but does not include access to streamed videos.)
