MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The new year of 2024 has now begun. This Sunday, on which we celebrate the feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, is already one full week into the new year – January 7. Monday is the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. After that, the Christmas season ends and Ordinary Time begins.

Did you make any New Year's Resolutions yet? Perhaps you have or perhaps you haven't, but it's not too late! In fact, I have a suggestion for a New Year's resolution for all of us to undertake. I will get to that in a minute. First, I want to tell you about my meditation I made during Adoration on Tuesday evening (January 2). I was preparing to play the organ to accompany night prayer and Benediction, so I was already in the choir loft of the church, and as I looked toward the altar, I realized I was gazing at the Word made Flesh, just like the shepherds who went in haste to Bethlehem and found the baby Jesus lying in the manger, and gazed upon Him in wonder and awe. The nativity scene in front of the altar showed the shepherds gazing upon the child Jesus, who, although He is God, "shared our human nature in all things but sin." He who knew no sin became one of us to save us from our sins. I thought to myself, "this is why we sing 'O come let us adore Him.'"

I realized that this same Jesus, true God and true man, was truly present in the Holy Eucharist on the altar that I saw with my eyes and adored. This presence was not an image, like the figures in the nativity scene. Jesus is present in the Eucharist substantially and tangibly. He is present in a way that is different from the way Mary and Joseph and the angels and saints are present to us when we pray to them and invoke their intercession. We have statues of Mary and Joseph in church, and of course, that nativity scene has figures of Mary and Joseph also gazing with wonder upon the child Jesus in the manger. As Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament concluded, I was again moved to contemplate the holiness and purity of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, as we recited the Divine Praises: "Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true man; Blessed be the great the great Mother of God, Mary most holy; Blessed be her holy and immaculate conception...Blessed be St. Joseph her most chaste spouse."

Here is where my suggestion for our New Year's resolution comes in. Let us resolve to adore Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament during this coming year, and let us renew our commitment of purity in thought, word and deed so that we may gaze with unhindered vision upon the Word made flesh who dwells among us.






