


Communion Song

After a brief winter break, rehearsals begin anew this month in preparation for Lent, Holy Week and Easter. Our ensembles meet on a seasonal schedule, allowing participants the flexibility of shorter-term commitments. Do you have a musical gift that you would be willing to share for the next few weeks?

- **St. Andrew Parish Choir** rehearses on Thursday evenings and sings for the 9:15 Mass on Sunday mornings in addition to other holy days and special occasions. There are currently openings for all voice parts, especially men.
