Purchased Assistive Listening Devices for parish community, helping those affected by hearing loss to fully participate in the weekly Mass.

Conducted a St. Andrew School Teacher Survey of Educational Needs.

Funded an Orton-Gillingham Training (OGT) for several St. Andrew elementary teachers. OGT is multi-sensory, kinesthetic, and phonics based. The OGT method has classically provided intensive rehabilitation in reading, spelling, writing, and reading comprehension for children with learning disabilities like dyslexia.

Offered a Summer Tutoring Program which served at-risk students to maintain skills and aid in knowledge retention.

Implemented an Accelerated Curriculum for the classroom with diagnostic resources and a professional library for grades 2nd through 8th.

Provided a Part-Time Educational Classroom Aide with a Masters in Special Education for first grade class.

Incorporated a highly effective handwriting curriculum called Handwriting Without Tears for the 2nd grade classroom that reinforce letter formation and enhances the writing and thought process and reading foundations.
