I want to thank everyone for their kind words of congratulations and good wishes on the occasion of my being awarded the Cross Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice last Sunday. I truly appreciate your kindness and support. The Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice Cross is a papal honor given to individual Catholics, clergy or laity, who have given extraordinary service to the Church. I am humbly grateful to Bishop Fernandes who nominated me for this honor in recognition of my years of service to the Diocese of Columbus, serving four bishops over the last 36 years. 

Adorers may stay as briefly or as long as they would like. At 8:45 p.m., Adoration concludes with Compline (end of day prayers), followed by Benediction. should be returned to the missal holder at the end of Mass.


ROSARY FOR LIFE: ALL ARE WELCOME!
