MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I want to share some news with you regarding St. Andrew Parish. The territorial boundaries have been officially changed and our parish now includes the area between the Scioto River and Sawmill Road, which is north of Bethel Road all the way up to Route 161. Previously, this territory was part of St. Brendan Parish. This change in parish boundaries has been in the works for some time. The Presbyteral Council

was consulted on September 26 and approved the change of boundaries on October 3.

This change really makes a lot of sense. There are a number of registered St. Andrew families who live in this area already. Physically, our church is closer to the area and more easy to access. There are four care facilities in this area and St. Andrew will assume responsibility for pastoral care to the residents there. We are working with St. Brendan to assure a smooth transition.

I do want to assure all of our registered parishioners, no matter where your home is located - whether within the territory of the parish or not - that St. Andrew is still "your parish." I also welcome any new parishioners from the annexed area and invite them to register in St. Andrew Parish.

For you information, I am providing the recently modified official description of the territorial boundaries of St. Andrew Parish.

ST. ANDREW PARISH TERRITORY

Northern boundary: The center of State Route 161 (west of Dublin-Granville Road) from the intersection of the center of the Scioto River and State Route 161, east to Sawmill Road; then south on the center of Sawmill Road to West Case Road: then east on the center of West Case Road to Godown Road: then south on the center of Godown Road to Bethel Road; then east on the center of Bethel Road to Kenny Road.

Eastern boundary: The center of Kenny Road from the intersection of Kenny and Bethel Roads on the north to Tremont Road on the south; then center of Tremont Road south to Ridgecliff Road.

Southern boundary: West on the center of Ridgecliff Road from Tremont Road on the east to Mountview Road: then north on the center of Mountview Road to Swansea Road: then west on the center of Swansea Road to Sunset Drive; then an air-line from the intersection of Swansea Road and Sunset Drive straight west to the center of the Scioto River.

Western boundary: The center of the Scioto River straight west of the intersection of Swansea Road and Sunset Drive on the south to the intersection of State Route 161 and the center of the Scioto River on the north.

For those who experience hearing loss and use hearing aids, St. Andrew Parish offers the telecoil, or T-coil, hearing loop system in the church. The T-coil hearing loop system substantially reduces most background noise and greatly improves understanding of speech and music.

If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church, you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.



AROUND THE DIOCESE

SACRED MUSIC WORKSHOP is scheduled for Saturday, Oct. 26, at St Andrew Church. SERRA CLUB ESSAY CONTEST: During October and November 2024, the Columbus Serra Club is challenging all Eighth grade boys in the Diocese to write an essay of five hundred words or less answering a question about whether God might be calling them to the priesthood. Writers of the ten best essays will be awarded a \$1,000 tuition assistance grant to a Diocesan Catholic high school. 


