

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

While I am sure we are all grateful for the plentiful rain that we have received over the last week or so, which has refreshed and renewed our parched lawns and fields, we are at the same time sorrowful and concerned for our neighbors affected by the destructive force of tropical storm Helene, which left more than 150 people dead, many missing, and devastated homes, businesses, cities and towns in both coastal and inland areas. I am sure you are eager to help our neighbors in distress. I will alert you if we are asked to take up a special collection for this purpose, but in the meantime, you may give directly to Hurricane Helene Relief at Catholic Charities USA (www.CatholicCharitiesUSA.org).

New parishioners should have received an invitation in the mail and via email to the New Parishioner Brunch scheduled for Sunday, Oct. 20. If you received an invitation, I encourage you to RSVP and attend the brunch so you can meet other new parishioners and we can properly welcome you to St. Andrew Parish.

Today, Sunday, Oct. 6, at 3:00 p.m., I will conduct the annual Pet Blessing in honor of St. Francis of Assisi (his feast day was on October 4). Mabel (my dog, almost 16 years old), and Melanie (a kitten we rescued, about 4 months old) look forward to welcoming all the pets and their people for this blessing.

A little later in the afternoon, I have to be at St. Joseph Cathedral for the 5:15 p.m. Mass where Bishop Fernandes will present me with the honorary papal award known as the "Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice." I am very humbled to be receiving this papal honor. You would be most welcome to join this celebration.

October is here and the countdown to the election has begun. Like any other group or subset of people in our country, the members of St. Andrew Parish will have different ideas about the candidates to support for political office. That is to be expected. A couple of weeks ago, I spoke about how we have communion with Christ and one another when we receive Holy Communion, and how we are all united as one body in the Body of Christ. While we certainly may be divided politically and ideologically, we must never allow these differences to divide the Body of Christ or disrupt the unity of faith, which must always be the primary mark of the Christ - one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic!

May God bless you all and keep you in His protective care!


AID AND SUPPORT AFTER PREGNANCY


