MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week, I have a few friendly reminders for you.

First of all, the eight-week active solicitation phase for The Appeal 2024 ended in June. I sent a follow-up letter in mid-June to remind parishioners of the need for support for this Diocesan campaign. We are more than halfway to our goal of \$221,413, but we still have a ways to go. We are about \$60,000 short of our goal. As I've explained, there is a new policy in place this year — parishes that do not meet their goal will have the amount that is short added to their assessment. It is very important that we reach our goal. My thanks to all who have contributed so far. I appeal to those who have not yet pledged to do so now, so we will quickly close the gap and reach our goal. The Appeal is a cause that deserves our enthusiastic support!

Secondly, I want to remind you that the priests of the parish are available to visit the sick, the homebound, the hospitalized, and especially the dying. We will assist with the sacraments, including penance, anointing of the sick, and Holy Communion! It is important to call the priests and request a pastoral visit before the need becomes urgent.

May God bless you all these warm summer days!




