# REST IN PEACE HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS

Pope Francis, who died April 21 at the age of 88, gave new energy to millions of Catholics as he transformed the image of the papacy into a pastoral ministry based on personal encounters and strong convictions about poverty, mission and dialogue. U.S. Cardinal Kevin J. Farrell, chamberlain of the Holy Roman Church, announced that Pope Francis had died at 7:35 a.m. "His whole life was dedicated to the service of the Lord and His Church," Cardinal Farrell said in a video announcement broadcast from the chapel of the Domus Sanctae Marthae, where Pope Francis lived.

Promoting peace, solidarity and respect for the Earth, the pope insisted people needed to recognize each other as brothers and sisters and issued an encyclical about that, "Fratelli Tutti, on Fraternity and Social Friendship." He signed the text at the tomb of St. Francis of Assisi on the saint's feast day, October 4, 2020.

Pope Francis spent much of the first nine years of his pontificate pursuing two ambitious projects: revitalizing the Church's efforts at evangelization – constantly urging outreach rather than a preoccupation with internal church affairs – and reforming the central administration of the Vatican, emphasizing its role of assisting bishops around the world rather than dictating policy to them.

On March 19, 2022, the ninth anniversary of the inauguration of his papacy, he finally promulgated "Praedicate Evangelium" ("Preach the Gospel"), his complete restructuring of the Roma Curia, highlighting its mission to serve the Church's evangelization efforts at all levels.

"Go out" was Pope Francis' constant plea to every Catholic, from curial cardinals to the people in the pews. More than once, he told people that while the Bible presents Jesus as knocking at the door of people's hearts to get in, today Jesus is knocking at the doors of parish churches trying to get out and among the people.

## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I was greatly saddened and also surprised when I learned of the death of our Holy Father Pope Francis early in the morning on Easter Monday. I heard the news at about 4:30 a.m. from the radio on my night stand. I was surprised because only a few hours before, I had watched news reports of the Pope's unexpected public appearance in St. Pete's Square.

Our celebration of Easter continues, but the joy of the season is tempered with sadness as we enter this period of mourning for Pope Francis. On the other hand, the Easter season increases our hope for everlasting life and our confidence in Christ's victory over death. This gives us consolation that Pope Francis has passed through death to everlasting life with Christ.

Today is the Octave day of Easter. If you saw Pope Francis's final message to the people gathered during his last public appearance to give the "urbi et orbi" blessing on Easter Sunday, you may recall that he wished them "Buona Pasqua." That means "Happy Easter." I find it meaningful that the Pope's last words to the faithful were words of happiness and hope.

I wish you all the happiness and joy of Easter. May Christ, who rose triumphant from the dead, dispel all the darkness and gloom from your hearts.

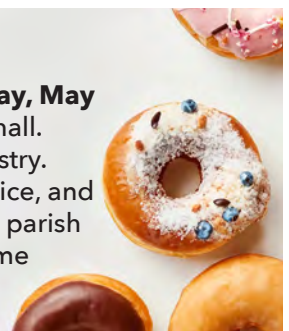
### FAMILIES NEED YOUR HELP:

The T-coil hearing loop system reduces most background noise and improves understanding of speech and music. **If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church**, you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

Please join us for Eucharistic Adoration on Tuesdays from 6:00-9:00 p.m. Eucharistic Adoration is simply the act of being in Christ's real presence while the Eucharist is on the altar. 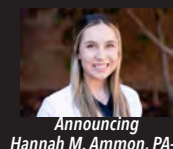
