MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The month of June has been a time of unusual activity around St. Andrew Church, especially as our roof replacement projects continue. The shingled roof areas of the school building have been replaced, as has the roof of the rectory. I hope that by the time you read this, the roof of the church will also be completed. I am saying this because, as I write this, the work is paused because of rain.

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also called "Corpus Christi Sunday." This feast reminds us that the Holy Eucharist is truly and substantially the Body and Blood of Christ. We believe that the bread and wine, which are consecrated at Mass, are changed from one substance to another through a process called "transubstantiation." This word signifies that the substance changes from bread and wine into being the true Body and Blood of Christ - but the accidental properties do not change; thus the Holy Sacrament looks and tastes like bread and wine, even though it is no longer bread and wine, but the true Body and Blood of Christ. This is why we worship and adore Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament, not only at Mass when we receive Him in Holy Communion, but also when kept in the tabernacle or shown in the monstrance during Eucharistic Adoration. He is truly and substantially present. This is the "Real Presence."

Starting Monday, June 23, I will be on vacation, which will conclude on July 4. I wish you all many blessings in this season of summer!




EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

I can suck my thumb!


Your spiritually adopted baby is quite active in the womb now, although his mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a


