



St. Andrew Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul 2022 Report to the Parish

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

During the 2021 Fiscal Year (October 1, 2021 – September 30, 2022), **17** full members and **13** associate members of St. Andrew's Society of St. Vincent de Paul participated in activities to serve those in need. Members responded to **85** requests, assisting **188** individuals and family members. **Thirty-seven** home visits/telephone consultations were made to people living in our parish area. Parishioner's monetary and "in kind" donations enabled the St. Vincent de Paul Society to continue <u>works of mercy</u> and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest areas of the diocese.






