MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

This coming week is one that calls for much prayer. There are several observances for which we need to pray.

First of all, we are in the midst of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, which takes place every year from January 18-25. During this week, we need to pray for the healing of all divisions in the Christian community "so that all may be one."

Also, Monday, Jan. 23, is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. Although the U.S. Supreme Court overturned the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* decision last year, which was an answer to many years of prayers, it remains important that we continue our prayerful efforts to protect and defend human life from conception to natural death.


Tuesday, Jan. 24, is the feast day of St. Francis de Sales, the primary patron saint of the Diocese of Columbus. It would be fitting and appropriate to pray for our diocese on that day, for our Bishop, and for all the faithful of our diocese, especially as we await the implementation of the "Real Presence, Real Future" recommendations.

On top of all that, this Sunday, Jan. 22, which is the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time, is designated as "Word of God Sunday." We hear the Word of God proclaimed to us in the Liturgy of the Word at Mass. Through the Scripture readings and psalms, God speaks to us. May we listen attentively and respond promptly and obediently.




NEW MEN'S WEEKLY BIBLE STUDY SERIES: THE BOOK OF ISAIAH
