Father DeVille, a Columbus native, was ordained on Dec. 22, 1962 in Columbus St. Joseph Cathedral by Bishop Clarence Issenmann.

He was pastor of Wellston Sts. Peter and Paul, and St. Timothy, Sacred Heart and Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal churches in Columbus. He was an associate pastor of Lancaster St. Peter,

Chillicothe St. Peter, Columbus St. Andrew, Columbus St. Matthias, Columbus Sacred Heart and Columbus St. Catharine churches, as well as the cathedral.

He also was a teacher at Lancaster Bishop Fenwick, Chillicothe Bishop Flaget, Columbus Bishop Watterson and Columbus St. Francis DeSales high schools; diocesan director of liturgy; and assistant diocesan vocations director. He also established the Divine Mercy devotion in the diocese.

He retired from active ministry on July 8. 2008, and has continued to serve here at St. Andrew during his retirement.




