MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

By now, everyone has heard the news that our Parochial Vicar Fr. Ferguson is being re-assigned this coming July and will become Parochial Vicar at St. Mary Parish in Delaware. July will be here before you know it, so I want to take a moment now to thank Fr. Ferguson for his priestly ministry and pastoral service to St. Andrew Parish these past three years He came to St. Andrew in the midst of the COVID-19 crisis, and helped to serve the needs of our parish through these unusual times. I wish him all the best in his new assignment.

I also want to thank our parishioners for your support for the special collection taken at Mass today for relief for the earthquake victims in Syria and Turkey. St. Andrew parishioners always respond with the utmost generosity to these extraordinary needs, and I am truly grateful for that.

I want to remind you of the opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation remaining before Easter. Confessions will be heard Friday evening March 31 beginning at 7:30 p.m.; on Saturday, April 1, from 3:15-4:15 p.m.; on Monday, April 3, "Reconciliation Monday," from 4:00-7:00 p.m.; and on Wednesday, April 5, from 7:00 p.m. until all are heard. For those lastminute procrastinators, there is one final opportunity immediately after the conclusion of the Good Friday liturgy on April 7. Please note there are no scheduled Confessions on Holy Saturday, April 8.

Tuesday, April 4, is the day of the annual "Chrism Mass." Bishop Fernandes will celebrate the Chrism Mass on Tuesday afternoon and all of the priests within our Diocese will join in this Mass when the holy oils are blessed and the priests renew their dedication to the holy priesthood. The priests are participating in a day of recollection prior to the Chrism Mass as well as a celebratory dinner. Because this is a long day for the priests, please note that Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Tuesday, April 4, will not begin until 7:00 p.m., which is when I hope to be back at the parish. Adoration will conclude with Compline and Benediction at 8:45 p.m. as usual.

Today, the Fifth Sunday of Lent, is the beginning of Passiontide. Let us solemnly praise and honor our Lord Jesus Christ, who by His holy cross, has redeemed the world!




EUCHARISTIC **ADORATION**

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Lent is moving along pretty quickly! As you know, I've been meowing to you about some of the great "saints" and "blesseds" who became holy and entered Heaven while



still pretty young. If you recall, I've told you about Blessed Carlo Acutis (age 15), Blessed Chiara Badano (age 19), and Saint Jose Sanchez del Rio (age 15).

Today, I want to purr to you about our final youth role model for this Season of Lent. Her name is St. Kateri Tekakwitha. That's meowed "Teh-kuh-WITH-a." St. Kateri was a Native American girl who was born in the year 1656 along the Mohawk River in northern New York State (not too far from where Father Ferguson comes from). Her parents died from smallpox when she was a little girl, and Kateri was raised by her uncle, who was a Mohawk chief. Kateri learned about Jesus from some local missionaries who wanted to share with others about the love of God. Kateri immediately wanted to live totally for God and try to be as holy as possible. However, her uncle did not like Christians, so he and a lot of the other Mohawks made life very miserable for Kateri.

As she got older, Kateri's family tried to get her to marry, but she did not want to. She wanted to live totally for Jesus. The pressure on her got so bad that Kateri had to leave her small town and travel north to the St. Lawrence River to live with Native Americans who were Christians and who supported her faith. Kateri spent much of her time doing penances and going really deep in prayer. She wanted to spend as much time as she could being with Jesus. Eventually, Kateri got ill (life in the wilderness was tough in those days), and Jesus brought her to heaven at the age of 24.

Father Ferguson once got to visit St. Kateri's birth village along the Mohawk River. Kateri is a great example of how the love of Jesus is open to everyone no matter their culture or race. Do you have friends who are different from you? Jesus loves them, too! And Jesus wants to help you become as holy and prayerful as Kateri, even as a young cat...errrr...as a young person! Why not take a few moments today and pray to St. Kateri Tekakwitha and ask her to help you stay strong and holy? Have a "purr"-fect week!




