MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I want to bring some very important information to your attention. There is a proposed amendment to the Ohio Constitution, which would, if passed, enshrine abortion rights into our state constitution. Currently, promoters of this proposed amendment are seeking signatures to get this proposal on the November ballot.

The Catholic Conference of Ohio and all our Ohio bishops are urging Catholics to pray and work to defeat this proposed amendment. The proposed amendment poses a clear threat to the sacredness of human life by negating current legal protections for the unborn, removing current safeguards for women, and making it easier for those who promote, provide or pressure women into abortions. The Catholic Conference of Ohio has inaugurated the "Protect Them Both" campaign to inform Catholics and urge them to action. In addition, I ask you to do the following:

PRAY the prayer for this campaign (available below).

DON'T sign the petition to place this proposed amendment on the ballot if asked to do so.

DO register to vote, and if the proposed amendment is on the November ballot, vote "no."

It is our responsibility as Catholics to take part in public life and to protect the common good, and especially to protect and promote the sanctity of life in all circumstances and stages of development. Let us do our part and keep this dangerous and unjust proposal from becoming law.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat!



Do you ever miss someone special when they leave you for a while? Maybe your best friend goes on a vacation for a couple of weeks, and you can't wait until he or she returns so you can get back to spending time with him or her. I always dislike it when Father Ferguson leaves me to travel out of town. I wish he could be with me all the time. That's why, as a cat, whenever I see Father packing his suitcase, I have a bad habit of jumping up onto his bed and biting him. Maybe that's why Father packs a lot more quietly lately, while I'm napping!

Today's special Solemnity at church reminds me of all this. It is Solemnity of the Ascension! That's right! The Ascension is the day – 40 days after the Resurrection – when Jesus went to the top of a mountain and ascended (went upwards) into Heaven. At first, Jesus' disciples were really sad. The Bible tells us that they just kept standing there, looking at the sky. They were probably thinking, "Jesus, don't leave us! We still want you here!"

Well, that would be a sad moment, except for the fact that Jesus actually still comes back to us even while He is in Heaven. That's what the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist is about! In the Eucharist – which we experience at every Mass – we get to see Jesus again in the most face-to-face way possible. So, really, Jesus has not left us at all; He is still truly present to us, and wants to keep preparing us for Heaven! That's the great message of the Solemnity of the Ascension. So, on this great day, as we still celebrate the Easter Season, take a few moments to thank Jesus for being with us so closely, especially in the Holy Mass! Have a "purr"-fect week!
