This weekend we are blessed with a number of observances and special occasions. Sunday is the Solemnity of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church! This feast commemorates the coming of the Holy Spirit, who descended upon the Apostles in tongues of fire, filling them with courage and zeal to go and proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ! The feast of Pentecost also marks the end of the Easter season.

This week, we also observe Memorial Day, a day to honor and remember those who have died in the service of our country. This day is also a day when we remember all of our deceased relatives and friends and pray for them. It is a good day to visit the cemetery and plant flowers on the graves of our loved ones who have gone before us.

THE RPRF RESULTS ARE AVAILABLE. On Thursday, May 25, the Columbus diocese released the final results of the *Real Presence, Real Future* (RPRF) initiative following an extensive three-year evaluation process.

The process began under Bishop Brennan in an effort to revitalize the diocese, while addressing the decline in Mass attendance and the priest shortage. Utilizing extensive feedback from clergy and the faithful within our community, recommendations were developed on a course of action. Carrying on that process, Bishop Fernandes spent his first year thoughtfully and prayerfully considering the recommendations, reviewing draft models, and gathering more information in an effort to make decisions that will help shape the mission of the diocese for current and future generations to serve its people in our 23-county area.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat!

Ooh! Ooh! Today is one of the most special days of the year! It's the Solemnity of Pentecost! That's right. Pentecost marks the moment when – 50 days after the Resurrection – Jesus sent His Holy Spirit upon the Apostles! This Holy Spirit gave the Apostles courage to go tell others about Jesus' love and salvation, as well as to go deeper in holiness no matter how tough it got.



Jesus wants all of us to receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit so that we, too, can do those same things: to tell others about Jesus, and to grow in holiness in preparation for Heaven. The Bible tells us that there are seven "gifts" of the Holy Spirit. Let's see if I can remember what they are: Knowledge, Understanding, Wisdom, Counsel, Fear (or deep respect) of the Lord, Fortitude, and Purring. Oops! That last one was incorrect. That was from the list of "Seven Reasons Why Cats Are Awesome." The seventh gift of the Holy Spirit is actually Piety.

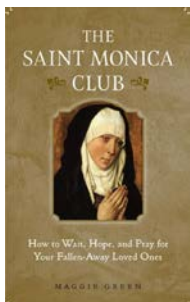
