MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I sincerely wish to thank St. Andrew parishioners for responding so generously to the Missionary Appeal last weekend. So far, we have received more than \$15,000 in donations for St. Joseph Church, Munroe Island, Kerala, India. Fr. Vinod spoke at Masses last weekend explaining the needs of this poor and remote mission and the challenges to effective evangelization because of the destruction of their church building. Your generous donations will make a significant impact. Once again, I express my thanks for your support for the missionary church. This is one way for us to share in the missionary aspect of the Catholic Church, spreading the Gospel to those who have yet to hear it.

The month of July is slipping by quickly. Today is already July 20. I hope that you will use the remaining days of summer wisely, and by that, I do not mean by working frantically and relentlessly. In summer, the pace of life should slow down a bit, giving us some time for leisure and perhaps introspection. I would like to suggest that if you find yourself with a little free time on these passing summer days, that you not look for something to do, but rather that you look inward and pray. In today's Gospel, Jesus chides Martha because she is "anxious and worried about many things," whereas Mary, who sat at Jesus' feet and listened to Him, "has chosen the better part." So let's make good use of these quickly passing summer days. Let us not make more work for ourselves, but instead, let us choose the better part and listen to Jesus speak to us.
