MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Recently, I was preparing for Sunday Mass, and as I placed the vessels with hosts and the cruet of wine in the back of the church, I reflected upon the offertory procession that takes place at Mass. I want to share my thoughts on this with you in the hope that you may better appreciate this meaningful gesture.


The "presentation of the gifts" is that moment during the Mass when members of the congregation carry the vessels of bread and wine forward and present them to the priest. Often, an entire family brings the gifts forward, sometimes with the young children proudly bearing the gifts. The priest receives the gifts, which then make their way to the altar where they will be consecrated and transformed to become the Body and Blood of Christ.

I can remember when this practice was restored after the Second Vatican Council and the inauguration of the "new Mass" of 1970. Back in those days, we often sang a song during the offertory that expressed the meaning of the Presentation of the Gifts. If you are my age, you may remember that song, "Take Our Bread." The refrain went like this: "Take our bread, we ask you take our hearts, we love you, take our lives, O Father we are yours, we are yours."

This song reminds us that the bread and wine presented at the offertory came from the people; they are the "fruit of the earth and work of human hands." These gifts are offered on the altar to Christ, who receives them and in a "holy exchange" gives them back to us as spiritual food and drink, His own Body and Blood. Christ takes "our" bread and gives us the Bread of Life!

In the presentation of gifts at the Mass, let us offer not only our gifts of bread, wine, and monetary donations, but also our whole selves, so that in return, Christ may give Himself to us completely in Holy Communion.
