MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

On Wednesday and Thursday of this week, the church honors two saints who are closely related - St. Monica and St. Augustine. St. Monica is the mother of St. Augustine.

St. Monica and St. Augustine both lived in the fourth century in northern Africa. We have learned much about them from Augustine's autobiographical account of his life and eventual conversion to the faith "Confessions." Augustine "confesses" that he led a rather restless life searching for meaning and fulfillment. He dabbled in the various philosophical and mystical movements of his day. Meanwhile, his mother, Monica, was praying that he would settle down and become a baptized and believing Catholic Christian. She prayed fervently and unceasingly to God for his conversion. Augustine felt God's call, but was still attached to his sinful habits and this also prevented his conversion. Finally, Monica's prayers were answered when Augustine, having been instructed by St. Ambrose in Milan, embraced the Catholic faith. Augustine went on to become the Bishop of Hippo and a great theologian and doctor of the Church.

St. Monica is invoked by those who pray for their children and loved ones who no longer practice the Catholic faith or have cut their ties with the Church. Just as St. Monica prayed for her son to embrace the faith, so they also pray that their "lost sheep" may be brought back into the fold. It seems like every Catholic family has some members who are estranged from the church or have quit practicing their faith. So those who love and care about them turn to St. Monica for help, and pray like she did, fervently and ceaselessly.

To commemorate St. Monica's feast day, I will be celebrating a special Mass on Wednesday, August 27, at 6:30 p.m. in the church for the Millions of Monicas prayer ministry in our parish. So, by all means, come and pray for your loved ones who have abandoned the Catholic faith, that they may return to the safety and communion of the Catholic Church.

MUSIC MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES



Seasonal rehearsals of our parish music ensembles begin soon, and new members are invited to join our ministry community! Do you have talents to share, or musical interests and abilities yet to be explored? Are you looking to reawaken your skills from music lessons long ago? Can you make a short eight-

week commitment to participate in one of our parish choirs? Here are some options to consider:

THE ST. ANDREW CHOIR provides music for the 9:15 a.m. Sunday Masses (September-June) in addition to other Holy Days, holidays, and special occasions. The group is open to men and women of high school age and beyond, and rehearsals are typically held on Thursday evenings at 7:00 p.m. While music reading ability is helpful, it is not required to become a choir member. You must simply be able to match pitch, blend your voice with others, be available for rehearsals as well as liturgies, and have a desire to help others pray and praise God through music. The choir season consists of four "quarters," and singers may sign up for any (or all) of the sessions as they are available throughout the year. Singers get an extended winter and summer break. Rehearsals begin in mid-September.

THE RESURRECTION (FUNERAL) CHOIR serves the parish by singing for our parish funerals throughout the year. This choir is an excellent option for those who enjoy singing and have some flexibility with their daytime (especially morning) schedules but are unable to commit to the Sunday choir. New members (both men and women) are always welcome. This choir is a meaningful way to honor our parishioners who have died, and to provide consolation to their loved ones in their time of loss.

THE ST. ANDREW HANDBELL CHOIR is the newest addition to our parish music ministry program. A basic knowledge of music reading is helpful for this group, but no previous ringing experience is necessary, and no singing is required! The Handbell Choir typically rehearses seasonally on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 p.m. with an extended winter and summer break. Introductory and tutoring sessions are offered, as needed, for those who would like to learn the basics of ringing. Now is the time to start!



The Witness of the Good Samaritan: Palliative Care and Hospice

"Death is a decisive moment in the human person's encounter with God the Savior. Helping the Christian to experience this moment with spiritual assistance is a supreme act of charity. It encompasses the patient with the solid support of human relationships to accompany them and open them to hope.

Palliative care and hospice are precious and crucial instruments in the care of patients with serious and complex chronic or terminal illnesses, and they help provide comfort to both the patients and their families.

While palliative care cannot entirely eradicate suffering from people's lives, it provides an authentic expression of human and Christian care – allowing us to 'remain' at the side of a suffering person, as the Blessed Mother and the beloved disciple remained at the foot of the Cross."




