### **MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR**

Dear Parishioners,

Recent events, including the Annunciation Church shooting in Minneapolis where two school children were killed, and the assassination of Charlie Kirk at Utah Valley University, have left me with one big question: Is there no respect for life in our American society any more? Have we become so callous and indifferent to the intrinsic value of human life that we have come to accept the arbitrary and ruthless acts of snuffing out human lives? I suppose that the long history of the acceptance of abortion in our nation has cheapened the value of human life in our society. The unborn are so expendable that the simple fact that they are unwanted is regarded as sufficient justification for their elimination.

Last Saturday, I participated in prayers of mourning for the victims of abortion in observance of the National Day of Mourning for Aborted Children. This took place at the memorial marker near the grotto outside St. Andrew Church. This was a very meaningful and important observance, and it helps us to remember that millions of human lives have been lost and should not be forgotten, not just to abortion but other forms of violent human malice.

At this time in our history, when we question whether there is any respect for life in our society, we must not forget any of those whose lives have been ended by human malice, indifference, or violence. Let us all pray and work to make respect for all human life, from conception to natural death, an enduring reality in these United States.






