MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The month of October has a double dedicaton: October is the month of the Rosary and it is also Respect Life Month. As we pray the Rosary and meditate on the mysteries of the Holy Rosary, we cannot help but be reminded of the sanctity of human life.

The first Joyful Mystery, the Annunciation, reminds us that life begins at conception. The angel announced to Mary that she would conceive in her womb and bear a Son, who is to be named Jesus.

The second Joyful Mystery, the Visitation, continues this theme. Elizabeth is in her sixth month of pregnancy with her unborn son (John the Baptist) and when Mary approaches having just conceived, Elizabeth's child leaps in her womb. The child, though still developing in the womb, is a living human being capable of feeling and activity.

The third Joyful Mystery, the Nativity of the Lord Jesus, though truly joyful, is also a reminder of the reality of poverty, homelessness, and lack of welcome for strangers.

Life begins at conception and must be protected and safeguarded up until natural death. That's not what happened in the case of Jesus. The fourth and fifth sorrowful mysteries of the Rosary remind us that Jesus was betrayed and condemned to death. Crucifixion was the method used by the Romans to carry out capital punishment. It was the means of execution. Jesus suffered the death penalty unjustly – but the death penalty itself is unjust because all human life is sacred, "from conception to natural death."

God is the author of all life. The Holy Spirit is the Lord and Giver of Life. The third glorious mystery reminds us that the Holy Spirit descended upon the Church so we could go out and proclaim the Gospel, the Gospel of Life! The glorious mysteries, especially the first mystery, Jesus' Resurrection from the dead, reminds us that God has made us for eternal life. He cancelled the sentence of death we incurred by original sin, and opened the gates of heaven to us.

As we pray the Rosary in this month of October, let us thank God for the gift of life, and do all in our power to protect and defend the sacredness of human life, from conception to natural death.
