MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Do you ever pay close attention to the post-communion prayer at Mass? This is the very short prayer prayed by the priest-celebrant just before the final blessing and dismissal. It is very brief, so it would be easy to miss. But this prayer always reminds us of what a deep and profound mystery the Holy Eucharist is, and helps us to appreciate the tremendous gift and privilege we have been given when we receive the Holy Communion. So it is important that we pay attention to it.

For example, the post-communion prayer the Sunday before last (27th Sunday in Ordinary Time) went like this: "Grant us almighty God, that we may be refreshed and nourished by the Sacrament we have received, so as to be transformed into what we consume. Through Christ our Lord."

Think about that for a moment! We have consumed the Body of Christ in the Holy Communion, and we ask to be transformed into what we consume, namely, the Body of Christ! Can you even begin to wrap your mind around this mystery and all that it means? I was still pondering that last Sunday (28th Sunday in Ordinary Time) when the post-communion prayer said this: "We entreat your majesty most humbly O Lord, that, as you feed us with the nourishment which comes from the Most Holy Body and Blood of your Son, so you may make us sharers of His divine nature." Wow! Make us, you and me, to share in the divinity of the Son of God? This is mind-blowing!

I have actually been doing a lot of thinking, contemplating and praying about the mystery of the Eucharist. Some weeks ago, as I was celebrating Mass and elevated the Sacred Host after the consecration, I was very conscious that I held the true Body of Christ in my hands, not just the human body He once offered on the cross to save us from our sins. I held the whole Body of Christ, head and members, the Church into which we were "incorporated" by Baptism, and even the totality of the heavenly Mystical Body of Christ whose members include the saints and all those who died in the peace of Christ! I was reminded that our receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion is what unites us all in the One Body of Christ, as it says in the third Eucharistic Prayer: "Grant that we who are nourished by the Body and Blood of your Son and filled with his Holy Spirit, may become one body, one spirit in Christ." Truly, we are being transformed into what we consume and becoming sharers in the divinity of Christ! I hope you will be reminded of these great truths of our faith when you listen and pray the post-communion prayer at every Mass.
