MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week is the last week of October. Can you believe that? This coming Friday is Halloween. Halloween falls on October 31, the very last day of the month of October. The following day, Saturday, Nov. 1, is the Solemnity of All Saints. Because it falls on a Saturday this year, it is not a holy day of obligation. This is because, years ago, the Bishops' Conference established a rule that when certain holy days of obligation fall on a Saturday or Monday, the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed that year. This is to avoid having two days of obligation back-to-back (e.g., a holy day and a Sunday).

Normally, we are obliged to attend Mass on All Saints Day and we schedule several Masses on the feast day so the faithful can fulfill their obligation at a convenient time. This year, the Solemnity of All Saints will be celebrated at only one Mass, the regular 9:00 a.m. Mass on Saturday, November 1. There will be no vigil Mass on Friday evening, or other Masses Saturday morning. The Saturday 4:30 p.m. Vigil Mass on November 1 will anticipate All Souls' Day, which falls on Sunday, Nov. 2.

All Souls' Day is a special day in the Church's calendar. It is not a holy day of obligation when it falls on a weekday, but rather it is a day dedicated to offering Mass and prayers for the faithful departed. But, when November 2 falls on a Sunday, Masses are celebrated for the "Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed" rather than for the current Sunday of Ordinary Time. This means that the 31st Sunday in Ordinary time will not be celebrated this year on Sunday, November 2.

I hope you are not too confused by all of this! Please enjoy this last week of October, and may God's blessings be upon you in abundance!




