MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The week before last (September 22-26), I attended the Priests' Convocation at Deer Creek State Park for all of the priests of the Diocese of Columbus. There were well over 100 priests in attendance and I was very happy to be among them. I especially appreciated the opportunity to concelebrate daily Mass – presided over by our Bishop – with so many of my brother priests.

The theme of the convocation was "Spiritual Fatherhood and Fraternal Brotherhood." The presenters included Fr. Benjamin Roberts of the Diocese of Charlotte, North Carolina; Fr. P.J. McManus of the Diocese of Des Moines, Iowa; and layman Anthony Isacco, PhD, a psychologist whose expertise is in assessing candidates for the clergy. The sessions were very interesting as they explored the topics of mature masculinity, the mental health challenges facing priests, and practical guidance for preaching more effectively, especially when giving homilies on difficult issues.

In addition to the main conference topics, we also had a presentation by the diocesan Tribunal about the new procedure for petitioning for annulments. We also learned about the SEEK conference, which is taking place in Columbus in early 2026, and we had a learning session, given by our diocesan insurance office about Medicare (especially for priests like me nearing retirement) and the other options available that support priests' wellness.

Ultimately, the convocation was successful and quite beneficial to me and my priestly ministry. I want to thank you for your prayers and support for me and the rest of the priests during our time away and every day.

October is Respect Life Month and also the month of the Rosary. Let us pray the Rosary with special care and devotion this month as we pray to end abortion and all other threats to the sanctity of human life.




