MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week, November 2 through 8, is National Vocation Awareness Week. This week is focused on the ever-present need for religious vocations in the church, especially to the holy priesthood. It is a time to help young people to consider whether God is calling them to the priesthood or religious life, and to provide resources to encourage them to follow God’s call. I believe that we should observe Vocations Awareness Week not only by praying for vocations, but also by encouraging young people, especially our own family members, to consider a religious vocation. Especially if we recognize the signs that make us think a young man would make a good priest, we should say something to encourage him to consider this way of life.

There is another way we can support vocations to the priesthood. Because there has been an increase in the number of seminarians in our diocese, there is a great need for resources to pay for their seminary studies, hence the need for this annual special collection. This collection will be taken up this weekend (November 1 and 2) at all Masses. Please be generous! And please pray for all our priests – past, present, and future!

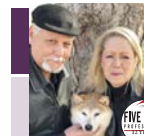
