MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This past July, I completed my 12th year as pastor of St. Andrew Parish. Normally, in the Diocese of Columbus, 12 years is the maximum time frame a priest is allowed to hold a pastorate (two terms of six years). The exception is if the pastor is approaching his 70th birthday. In that case, the pastorate can be extended by a year or more until he reaches retirement age.

On March 27, 2026, I will turn 70 years old. For the last couple of years, I have been operating under the assumption that I would be retiring from parish administration in 2026, and have been making preparations to do so. (You may remember a Sunday homily when I mentioned the difficulties I encountered with downsizing.) A couple of weeks ago, I had a conversation with Bishop Fernandes and he asked me to remain as pastor of St. Andrew Parish for an additional year. I agreed to this. While I had previously indicated my desire to retire in 2026, I also stated that I would stay another year if necessary and the Bishop desired it. I am not too surprised to find out that my retirement has been postponed until 2027.

I am happy that I will be spending this additional year of active ministry with all of the wonderful people of St. Andrew Parish, and I hope that all of you will be able to put up with me for one more year!

I have always liked the month of November, even the sometimes gray skies and chilly air. It is a quiet, serious time, conducive to introspection and solitude. Let us continue throughout this month to remember and pray for the souls of the faithful departed, especially our own family, friends, and benefactors. May they rest in peace!

»THE HEARING LOOP SYSTEM IS AVAILABLE DURING MASS: For those who experience hearing loss and use hearing aids, St. Andrew Parish offers the telecoil, or T-coil, hearing loop system in the church. The T-coil hearing loop system reduces most background noise and improves understanding of speech and music. **If you would like to take advantage of the T-coil function in the church,** you will need to ask your Hearing Care Provider (HCP) to add it to your device. After this, simply press the button on the back of your hearing aid and select the program that your HCP has assigned to T-coil.

Dear Parishioners,

St. Andrew Parish and the Diocese of Columbus remain steadfast in our commitment to child protection and safety. To strengthen protection for children, youth, and vulnerable adults across all parishes, schools, and ministries, the Diocese of Columbus has updated its Safe Environment policies. The most notable change for all diocesan volunteers is to the background check process.

IF YOU ARE AN ACTIVE, COMPLIANT VOLUNTEER...

Effective January 2, 2026, ALL VOLUNTEERS are required to have a current, clear BCI background check (and FBI if applicable) on file to continue volunteering. This background check must be renewed every five years. If your last background check is dated BEFORE January 2, 2021, your results have expired (or will expire soon). **You may not volunteer again in any capacity until your background check has been updated and approved.** Use the QR and information in the call-out box below to schedule an appointment at Fast Fingerprints.

If you don't know the date of your last background check, go to <https://virtusonline.org> and enter your User ID and Password to access your Virtus account. If you've forgotten your login credentials, select "Need login information?" and reset your information.

IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN BECOMING A COMPLIANT VOLUNTEER...

Effective immediately, to become a fully compliant volunteer, you MUST complete ALL volunteer requirements before the first date of service. For details, visit <https://www.standrewparish.cc/parish-involvement/volunteers/>.

If you are unsure of your current volunteer status, need help with the renewal process, or have questions about becoming a volunteer, contact **Safe Environment Coordinator Mary Beasecker** at mbeasecker@standrewparish.cc.

PLEASE NOTE: No one may begin working or volunteering within the Diocese of Columbus, including St. Andrew Parish, until all safe environment requirements, including Protecting God's Children training and a current background check, have been completed and approved.

We are grateful for all the ways you give your time and talents to our parish and school. Your support makes a tremendous difference in the programs and activities we offer. This process enables us to provide a safe and welcoming environment for the youngest in our parish and school community.

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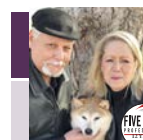
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
