## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week, I would like to continue my reflections on "mindfulness," which I began in my message in last weekend's bulletin. I stated that mindfulness is the grace of living in the present moment. I have continued to reflect on this and the challenges I experience when trying to stay focused on the present. Sometimes, I have to stop and remind myself what day it is, even the year. When you follow a daily routine, it can happen that one day seems a lot like another. But, each day is unique and deserves to be lived to its fullest. It is good to remember where we are in life. Especially as we age, we may not notice how much things have changed around us. Simply calling to mind the day and date can focus our attention on the possibilities and potential of today.

In this season of Advent, each day is unique. I have been trying hard to be mindful of each day of Advent, with its unique meaning presented in the Liturgy and the specific themes in the Scripture readings for each day. My point is this: If we want to be mindful and live in the present moment, we need to remember what day it is, and where this day falls in the sequence of the days of our life. And remembering the season and the position in the liturgical calendar is also helpful. For example, today (as I write this) is Tuesday, Dec. 9, 2025, of the second week of Advent. I have really been making an effort to be mindful of each and every day of Advent, to live it fully, and to appreciate its uniqueness.

I have also discovered that, if I want to be mindful and live in the present moment, I need to stop being a slave of the clock. Ever since I was a child, I have liked and appreciated clocks, and I have collected a few over the years. But if we are always watching the clock, we are likely to overlook the present moment while we look ahead to what's next. Or, we feel that time is running out so we hurry past the present moment so we aren't late for that whose time has not yet come. I made this mistake recently when I woke early on a Sunday morning. I looked at my clock on the night stand and thought it read 5:45 a.m. I got up and went over to the church to unlock the doors and turn on the lights. When I looked at the clock in the sacristy, it was only 3:30 a.m.!

Another way to remain focused on the present and to appreciate the uniqueness of each day is to review your day's experiences at the end of the day before retiring. Not only does this serve as an examination of conscience, but by reviewing your activities and encounters of the day in reverse, you will realize the many ways God was at work in the people you met, the good that you did, the kindness you were shown, and the difficulties you overcame.

I want to encourage all of you to greater mindfulness in this season of Advent!

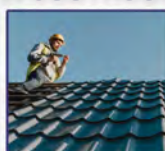
